

LAKE LAWRENCE COMMUNITY CLUB PAT HAMM MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Pat Hamm (1934–2008) devoted her adult life to accounting and its practice even after retirement by giving to the Lake Lawrence Community Club (LLCC) years of service. Her combination of fiscal expertise and fearless vision continues to inspire and motivate the Lake Lawrence Community Board to remember her and offer this scholarship.

Scholarships will be awarded based on the strength of candidates' academic background, strength of essay and demonstrated leadership. The scholarship recipient(s) will receive a minimum of \$250 for the next academic year.

All scholarship recipients will be invited to visit the Lake Lawrence Community Club annual recognition dinner to be recognized.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must:

- Be in their senior year of High School.
- Be enrolled in full-time study during the school year.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 or equivalent in their current program through their junior and senior years.
- Show graduation with a 3.0 GPA and college enrollment by October 1st to receive scholarship.
- Have a family member or guardian as a member of LLCC in good standing.

HOW TO APPLY

Scholarship applications will be available in October of each year for the next scholarship cycle. Applications may be found on the LLCC web site, by calling the LLCC office (360-894-2281), or from your school counselor.

Patsy Hamm (1934-2008)

Pat was born in Afton, Texas. The family moved to Lubbock, Texas in 1938. She graduated from Lubbock High School in 1951 where she then went to work for AT&T. Pat met and married her husband Bill who was serving in the US Navy. They moved to San Diego where Patsy continued her quest for added skills and knowledge through subsequent employment with AT&T customer relations assignments. She also had a few years with various assignments working in a savings and loan association and an accounting firm where she became deeply involved and skilled in the laws and statutes regulating and reporting election donations and spending. She retired in 1996 and moved to Lake Lawrence where Pat held the position of Treasurer on the Board of Directors for the Lake Lawrence Community Club, providing neighbors and surrounding community members with support and service.
